- 1) Miru Miru, 2006** SWIG £12.50
A vintage sparkler from New Zealand. The grape varieties are the same as used in Champagne

- 2) Flagstone Two Roads, 2005** SWIG, £9.95
A blend of 6 varieties from South Africa. *Sauvignon Blanc, Chardonnay, Riesling, Pinot Blanc, Semillon & Muscat*

- 3) Bogle Viognier, 2007** Great Western Wine, £9.95
Produced by a family firm in California

- 4) Reserve Personnelle, Paul Boutinot, 2003** SWIG, £8.95
A blend of Carignan, Syrah and Mourvedre from the French AOC of Cotes de Roussillon Villages.

- 5) La Planta , 2007** SWIG, £12.00
100% Tempranillo from the Spanish DOC of Ribera del Duero.

- 6) Vistalba, Corte B 2004** Great Western Wines, £12.20
An Argentinean wine that combines Malbec, Cabernet Sauvignon, Bonardo & Malbec

- 7) Duas Quintas Reserva, 2004** Ramos Pinto, £25.00
A Portugese red wine from the Douro Valley made by a very highly rated Port producer.

- 8) Brown Brothers, Orange Muscat & Flora (37.5cl)** Waitrose, £6.45
A late harvest wine from a long established Australian producer. Both varieties are very rare.
